1. The Undersigned Owner hereby agrees to breed his

to the Stallion _____ Reg. No. _____

standing at Bradford Quarter Horses, Inc., doing business as Sliding J Ranch (herein referred to as SJR) and Jenny Simao Equine Services, doing business as West Coast Equine (herein referred to as "WCE") for the _____ breeding season and to pay SJR, WCE the stud fee of \$ _____ plus board and expenses. Of this amount, a booking fee of \$ _____ and a chute fee of \$ _____, both non-refundable, are payable upon the execution of this contract. Board and expenses are payable monthly as billed, and the balance of the stud fee plus all unpaid board and expenses will be paid before said mare is picked up. The chute fee covers basic rectal and ultrasound examinations (additional rectal/ultrasound exams will be charged on embryo transfer mares on non-breeding days). All other veterinary reproductive fees such as cultures, hormone injections, intrauterine infusions and any other medications or treatments deemed necessary or appropriate will be billed to the mare owner monthly.

2. SJR, WCE agrees to try diligently to settle said mare up to and including June 30, _____ unless otherwise arranged at the time of signing of this contract.

3. Mare owner agrees to provide a photocopy of the mare's registration papers, a negative Coggins test, and a record of immunization for tetanus, Eastern and Western Equine Encephalomyelitis, equine influenza, West Nile, and rhinopneumonitis, in addition to worming history, prior to breeding.

4. SJR, WCE, its owners, employees, and the stallion owners will not be responsible for any disease, accident, sickness or death of said mare or of foal; and may exercise its judgment in caring and supervising for them. The owner hereby warrants that he has made himself familiar with the facilities at the SJR, WCE and that he is also familiar with and approves of the care provided by the ranch.

5. SJR, WCE may have a veterinarian check said mare for normal breeding conditions, and perform, at its absolute discretion such other veterinary services as it deems necessary or appropriate for the mare or foal at owner's expense. This includes but is not limited to the following: worming, treating for infections, disease or accident related conditions, preventative measures, palpation examination and pregnancy checking, and emergency treatment including removal to a veterinary facility at owner's expense as deemed necessary by SJR, WCE or the treating veterinarian for the best interest of the horse.

6. If said mare does not settle or if said mare does not produce a live foal, Owner will be entitled to a re-breed the following year only. This privilege to a re-breed the following year only shall be subject to the condition that in cases of death of a foal before it stands and sucks, Owner notifies SJR, WCE of the death of the foal within one week thereof in writing; such notice must be accompanied by a signed statement from a licensed veterinarian indicating such condition. Stallion fee will not be refunded. A chute fee of \$ _____ will be charged on all re-breeds to be paid by Owner and Owner agrees to the same terms as set forth in this contract.

7. If said mare is removed from SJR, WCE immediately after breeding and before being checked for pregnancy, a \$ _____ rebreed charge is due each time mare is brought back to be bred again during the contract year. For each (embryo transfer) pregnancy that is confirmed 40 days in foal, there will be a new stallion service contract completed of which stud fee and booking fee shall be payable.

8. Stallion owner will issue a Breeder's Certificate upon notification of the birth of the foal, after payment of all breeding fees, boarding fees, expenses and veterinary charges.

9. When both parties (authorized representative of SJR, WCE and Owner) have signed this contract and a copy has been returned to Owner, this contract will be a binding contract by both parties. This contract is not transferable nor assignable.

10. Monthly statements will be mailed to Owner for services as hereinabove provided. Such statements shall be due and payable upon billing. If any such statement is not paid within ten days following billing, a billing charge of 1 1/2% of balance due per month will be added and Owner agrees that the stud fee hereinabove provided shall, notwithstanding any provisions herein to the contrary, be immediately due and payable, whether or not said mare has been settled, and all obligations of SJR, WCE, its owners, employees or agents hereunder shall cease.

11. Neither SJR, WCE, the stallion owner, nor any of their representatives shall be liable to the Owner of the mare or any other person for the failure of the mare to produce a live foal for any reason whatsoever.

12. The Owner hereby releases SJR, WCE, and its agents and employees from any liability for sickness, disease, accident, injury, or loss of the horse while in the care, custody and control of SJR, WCE or while in transportation by or procured by SJR, WCE.

13. The Owner agrees that if SJR, WCE should at any time find it necessary to commence legal proceedings to collect any of the above stated fees or expenses or otherwise to enforce this contract, or be required to defend any legal proceedings relating to this contract, the prevailing party, will be entitled to court costs and attorney's fees entailed in such proceeding and those will be added as costs to the amount due. Time is of the essence in this contract. Any express or implied waiver of any breach of this contract shall in no way be construed to be a waiver of any subsequent breach or of any other default or a modification of any of the terms of this contract.

14. ALL CHARGES AND FEES INCURRED IN CONNECTION WITH THE MARE MUST BE PAID IN FULL BEFORE THE MARE MAY BE REMOVED FROM THE RANCH. FAILURE TO PAY CHARGES/FEES MAY RESULT IN THE MARE BEING SOLD IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE LIVESTOCK SERVICE LIEN LAW (CALIFORNIA CIVIL CODE, SECTION 3080, ET SEQ.)
